

# **l**pfront

Print media is a tough business. This is not breaking news.

My first boss after business school, Wes Edens, has recently increased his holdings in print assets like daily newspapers, when Gate-House Media, a company he and his private equity firm control, struck a deal to acquire the nation's largest newspaper chain, Gannett. The GateHouse/Gannett merger widens the distribution gap between the combined entity and the next-biggest newspaper publisher. Incidentally, GateHouse owns The Savannah Morning News, among its many titles.



When I was with him, those things were mortgage loans, particularly ones issued and held by savings-and-loans that failed during the crisis that decimated the s-and-l industry. It turns out that the institutions were troubled, but many of the home loans they held were perfectly fine. When the federal government, in the form of the Resolution Trust Company, rushed to liquidate billions (if not trillions) in s-and-l assets, smart guys like Wes stood ready to buy the stuff in bulk.

Think of a newspaper as an asset with embedded value and a diminished owner. It's a community resource with a strong brand identity. But it is burdened by its connection to an antiquated business

model: Print ads are hard to sell, and printing publications is expensive. Meanwhile, people are falling over one another in a rush to give away, free of charge, the information that newspapers provide, faster than newspapers can provide it. And print publishing organizations don't have the free cash or collective expertise to reshape themselves. So, what would a smart guy do? Leverage the brand value and blow up the delivery systems. In 10 years, will you be able to (awkwardly) hold the local morning paper in your ink-stained hands? Don't bet on it.

If Wes is buying newspapers, they must be 1) in trouble, 2) potentially transformable, and 3) pretty cheap. After all, he bought the Milwaukee Bucks before you ever heard of the Greek Freak.

Magazines share newspapers' pains. The Skinnie has been a bi-weekly staple for more than 16 years. That's a pretty good run. Business has been tough for year or two. My team has worked hard to trim costs, often at their own personal expense. We have refocused our efforts to conceive and create content that will continue to engage our readers – you. And we remain committed to the organizations and people who count on us to build awareness for their work. Our fundamental belief – that an open forum for free, untainted expression is important – hasn't changed.

But we don't have the wherewithal to do "a Wes." So we will take baby steps. Rather than converting to a subscription model, we will continue to reach every household in our market. Concurrently, we are trying to build digital capacity so that you can interact with us in more ways than reading our book every other week. Please follow us on Instagram, @the\_skinnie\_magazine. 





singular instance can serve as a seminal catalyst for a series of life choices that follows. During David Sedory's senior year in high school in Tampa, Florida, he volunteered at a nearby Shriners Hospital for Children. A friendly surgeon invited Sedory to observe an operation in close proximity, stirring the high schooler's interest in the medical profession. And he was so taken by the surgeon's work that Sedory decided to pursue surgery himself.

After high school, Sedory attended Washington University in St. Louis, where his high grade point average earned him a Dean's scholarship award. At the time, he was enrolled in the university's Army ROTC program, with a pending active duty obligation after graduation. However, Sedory's service was put on hold when he was accepted to Case Western Reserve's School of Medicine in Cleveland, Ohio. Sedory was awarded an Army HPSP scholarship, which pays for medical school in exchange for active military duty; one year of service for each year of medical school.

After earning his medical degree, Sedory began his four-year active duty obligation in 2005. The Army sent him to San Antonio Military Center in Texas for his residency and internship in orthopedic surgery, his preferred specialty.

When his formal medical training was completed, then a captain, Sedory reported for his first duty station as the staff orthopedic surgeon at Winn Army Community Hospital, Fort Stewart.

In 2011, Sedory was deployed with the 126th Forward Surgical Team (FST), to Farah, Afghanistan, in support of Operation Enduring Freedom. The province of Farah is in western Afghanistan near the border with Iraq. The area is a combat hot zone.

The primary purpose of an FST is for surgeons to treat combat casualties within the "golden hour" of injury, until the wounded can be evacuated to a higher level of medical care. In many cases, the treatment is lifesaving. Most of the cases Sedory tended to were caused by improvised explosive devices (IEDs).

# Turkey-Vegetable Soup With Parm-potato Patties

By Scott Lauretti

Like most of the things I make in my kitchen, this recipe hints at Italy. The mashed-potato patties are reminiscent of polpetti (meatballs), although they don't contain meat. Instead of tomato sauce, yesterday's gravy accents theses potato "polpetti." They are deliciously-browned accompaniments to a comforting, rustic soup that uses almost everything you stuffed in the fridge after Thanksgiving dinner. Despite the length of the ingredient list and the several steps required, this recipe is fairly easy if you take it step-by-step

### **INGREDIENTS**

- 8 c chicken broth
- 1 turkey carcass, meat removed
- 3 carrots, cut into 2-inch pieces, plus 1 carrot, chopped
- 3 celery stalks, cut into to 2-inch pieces, plus 1 stalk, chopped
- 1 yellow onion, cut into wedges, plus 1 yellow onion, chopped
- 2 bay leaves
- 3 c dark turkey meat, chopped
- 2 c white turkey meat, chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, smashed

- ½ c olive oil
- 4 c leftover cooked Thanksgiving side vegetables (e.g. Brussels sprouts, sweet potatoes, green beans)
- 1 tbsp fresh sage, chopped
- 4 c leftover mashed potatoes
- 1 c freshly grated Parmigiano-reggiano cheese
- All-purpose flour
- Black pepper

### DIRECTIONS

Put the chicken broth, turkey carcass, 2-inch carrot pieces, 2-inch celery pieces, onion wedges, and 1 bay leaf in a large stockpot. If the liquid doesn't cover the turkey, add water to do so. Season generously with salt and freshly ground black pepper. Bring to a boil and then simmer, about 1 ½ to 2 hours. eat. Before straining the broth, remove the large bones and carcass with tongs. Strain the broth through a sieve covered with wet cheesecloth. Discard the solids. Transfer the broth to a bowl and cool.

In a large soup pot, heat a ¼ c of the olive oil to medium-high and add the crushed garlic. Brown garlic slightly, for about 2 minutes. Add the chopped carrots, celery and onion. Sweat over medium-low until softened, about 8 minutes. Add the sage to the soup pot along with the turkey broth and the remaining bay leaf. Bring to a simmer. Chop the leftover Thanksgiving vegetables. When simmering, add the Brussels sprouts, green beans and chopped turkey meat to the soup. Return to a simmer. Add the sweet potatoes to the center and gently push them down. Turn the heat off and cover. Allow to sit and steam. (Return to a simmer for 5 minutes more when you're ready to serve.)

Re-season mashed potatoes with salt and pepper. Stir in grated cheese. Form the potato-cheese mixture into small patties and place on a baking sheet. In a large skillet, heat the remaining \( \frac{1}{4} \) c of olive oil over medium-high. Dredge the patties in flour. Add the patties to the oil without crowding them (you may have to cook them in batches). Cook until the underside is golden brown, about 5 minutes. Flip and brown the other side. Remove from the skillet and drain on paper towels. Serve hot with leftover gravy alongside bowls of soup.


